

## **Broker Checklist: Alarm & Security Changes**

BT All IP by 2027 – Landline Phase-Out  Identify clients with centrally monitored intruder or fire alarms connected via traditional landline (PSTN).
$\square$ Advise upgrade to equipment compatible with fibre optic, mobile, or IP paths.
☐ Completion target: January 2027, but changes could occur earlier.
BT Redcare Legacy Product Withdrawal – December 2025  ☐ Check if clients use BT Redcare Classic, Secure 2, Secure 3, Secure IP, or GSM.
☐ If yes, arrange upgrade to Next Generation Portfolio (Advanced, Advanced Extra, Essential Essential Extra, Essential IP, Ultimate) or alternative solutions.
☐ Deadline: 15 December 2025.
Monitoring Equipment & Grading  ☐ Confirm alarm monitoring meets appropriate SP (single path) or DP (dual path) standards.
☐ For medium/high-risk sites, recommend DP for redundancy.
$\square$ Ensure catastrophic failure reporting time matches insurance requirements.
Alarm System Grade & Compliance  ☐ Verify alarm grade: Grade 2 for low/medium risk, Grade 3 for medium/high risk.
$\square$ Ensure wireless alarms use an independent encrypted frequency (not Wi-Fi).
☐ For police response, ensure client holds a URN (Unique Reference Number).
